To all JP-Transit Riders

In the event of a hurricane, the Jefferson Parish Transit system will maintain regular bus service until the Parish is placed under a mandatory evacuation notice when threatened by a Category 3, 4, or 5 Hurricane. At that time, the regularly scheduled fixed route service will be replaced with the Hurricane Evacuation System (See map on this page).

Upon official notice from the Parish President, Jefferson Parish Transit will operate hurricane evacuation routes to bring transit riders to one of two Parish Pick-up Points. Buses will run along the routes shown on the Hurricane Evacuation System Map for JP-Transit.

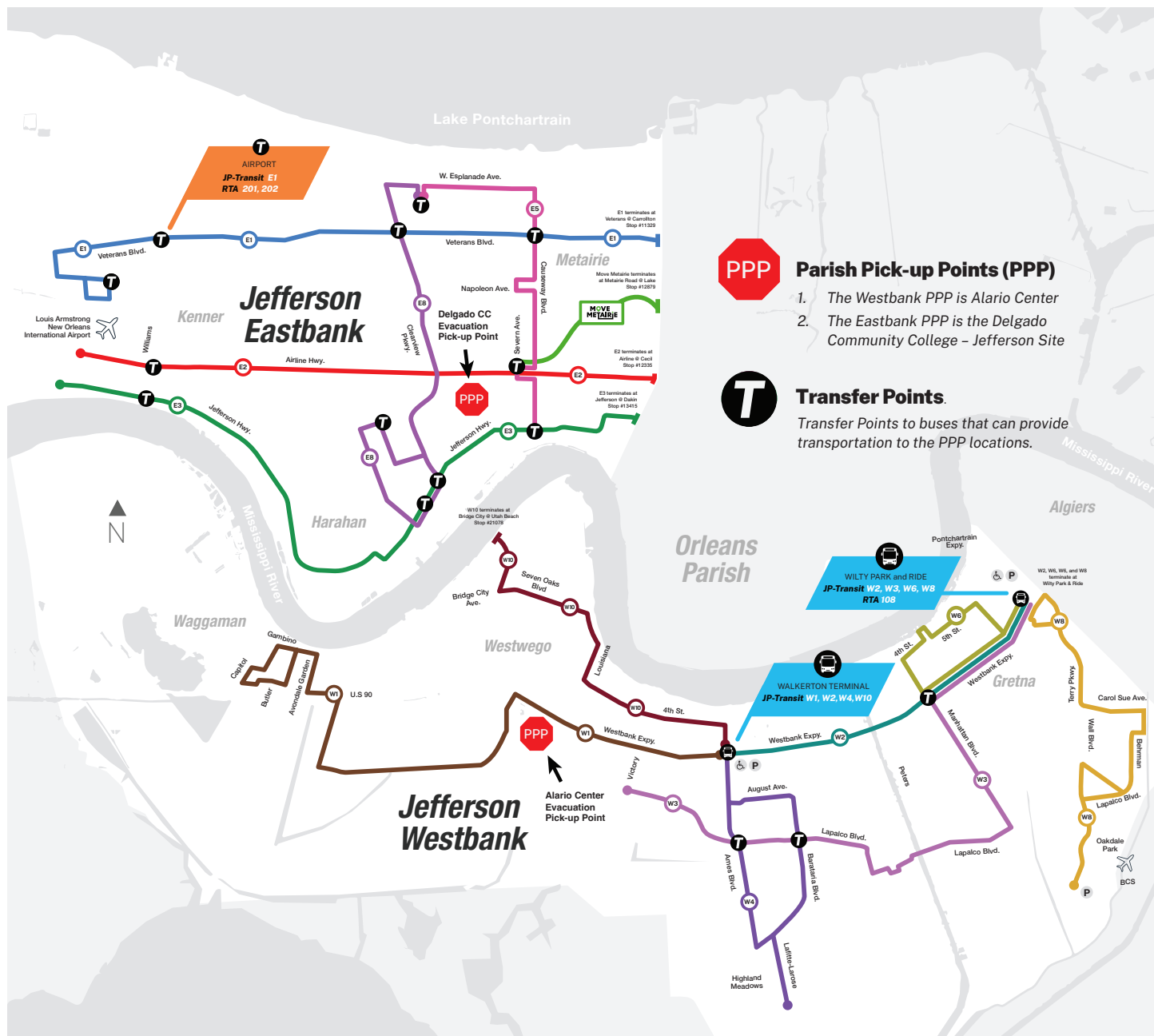
Please note that the Hurricane Evacuation routes may be different from the regular JP-Transit routes and please check the Hurricane Evacuation Maps regularly for updates and changes. Refer to the Hurricane Evacuation Map for details and please note:

- **No fares will be collected during Hurricane Evacuation.**
- **JP-Transit operators will pick up passengers at JP-Transit bus stops along the designated routes.**
- **Riders are limited to one bag per person no larger than 30" x 16".**
- **JP-Transit will transport animals only in carriers. If transporting large or exotic animals, please call Jefferson Parish Transit at (504) 818-1077 or (504) 818-1077.**

MITS - Paratransit Service: Hurricane Evacuation Procedure

Before a storm is in the Gulf, discuss your plans for evacuation with your family. Visit www.getagameplan.org for details. If a major hurricane approaches and the Parish President declares a mandatory evacuation, **the Parish will activate its special needs evacuation assistance plans to help those without means to evacuate.** You will be given a number to call to get the assistance you need.

Hurricane Evacuation Routes Details

Eastbank Routes

The following Eastbank routes will bring riders to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at Delgado Community College – Jefferson Site. Please note the transfer points on each route.

E1 Veterans-Airport

Two buses will run on Veterans between Veterans and Loyola and the Jefferson/Orleans parish line. Riders will transfer to the E8 Elmwood route at Veterans and Clearview to travel to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at Delgado Community College on Airline Drive.

***E2 Airline Drive**

Two buses will run on Airline between Kenner Terminal Garage and Jefferson/Orleans Parish Line. Riders will transfer to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at Delgado Community College on Airline Drive.

E3 Jefferson Highway

Two buses will run on Jefferson Highway between the Jefferson/St. Charles Parish line to the Jefferson/Orleans Parish line. Riders will transfer to the E8 Elmwood route at Elmwood Park Blvd. to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at Delgado Community College on Airline Drive.

E5 Causeway

One bus will run between East Jefferson Hospital and Jefferson Highway. Riders will transfer to the E2 Airline route at Airline to travel on to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at Delgado Community College on Airline Drive.

***E8 Elmwood**

Two buses will run between East Jefferson Hospital and Jefferson Highway. Riders will be dropped off at the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at Delgado Community College on Airline Drive.

Move Metairie - Bus Service Only (No Lyft) During Evacuation

One bus will run on Metairie Road between the Jefferson/Orleans Parish line and Severn. Riders will transfer to the E2 Airline route at Severn and Airline Drive to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at Delgado Community College on Airline Drive.

Westbank Routes

The following Westbank routes will bring riders to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at the Alario Center. Please note the transfer points on each route.

***W1 Avondale**

One bus will travel from the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at the Alario Center to Avondale (Senate Dr @ Capitol).

***W2 Westbank Expressway**

Two buses will travel from the Wilty Terminal to the Walkertown Terminal then to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at the Alario Center. (No service across the Crescent City Connection).

***W3 Lapalco**

Two buses will travel from Westbank Expressway @ Manhattan, down Manhattan to Lapalco and then to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at the Alario Center.

W4 Marrero

One bus will travel on its regular route. Riders will transfer to the W2 Expressway route at the Walkertown Terminal to travel to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at the Alario Center.

W6 Gretna

One bus will travel on its regular route to the Wilty Terminal. Riders will transfer to the W2 Westbank Expressway route at the Wilty Terminal to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at the Alario Center.

W8 Terrytown

One bus will travel on its regular route in Terrytown to the Wilty Terminal. Riders will transfer to the W2 Westbank Expressway route at the Wilty Terminal to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at the Alario Center.

***W10 Huey P. Long**

One bus will travel on its regular route from Walkertown Terminal to Bridge City (No service across the Huey P. Long Bridge) Riders will transfer to the W2 Expressway route at the Walkertown Terminal to travel to the Parish Pick-up Point (PPP) at the Alario Center.

* Route names in Red provide direct service to PPP with no transfer needed.
