Security Equipment

- 1 Slide windows are equipped with emergency opening system for evacuation purposes.
- 2 Multiple cameras and digital video recorder on each bus.
- 3 Two emergency escape hatches on top of each bus.
- 4 Each bus is equipped with two-way radio communication systems.
- 5 Vehicles are equipped with hands-free public address systems.
- 6 Coach identification numbers are displayed in a total of seven places inside and outside vehicles.
- Wheelchair ramps and lifts can be manually operated in the event of system failure or emergency.
- Signage posted in every vehicle informing passengers of safety, operational, and security issues.
- 1 Doors are located for easy egress in the event of an emergency.
- Reflective decals and striping located on the front, sides, and rear of each vehicle make the buses more visible to traffic as well as to emergency responders/law enforcement.
- 1 Transit Security Messages are broadcast over the Voice Annunciator System every 30 to 45 minutes.
