Jefferson Parish Riders Hurricane Evacuation Procedure:

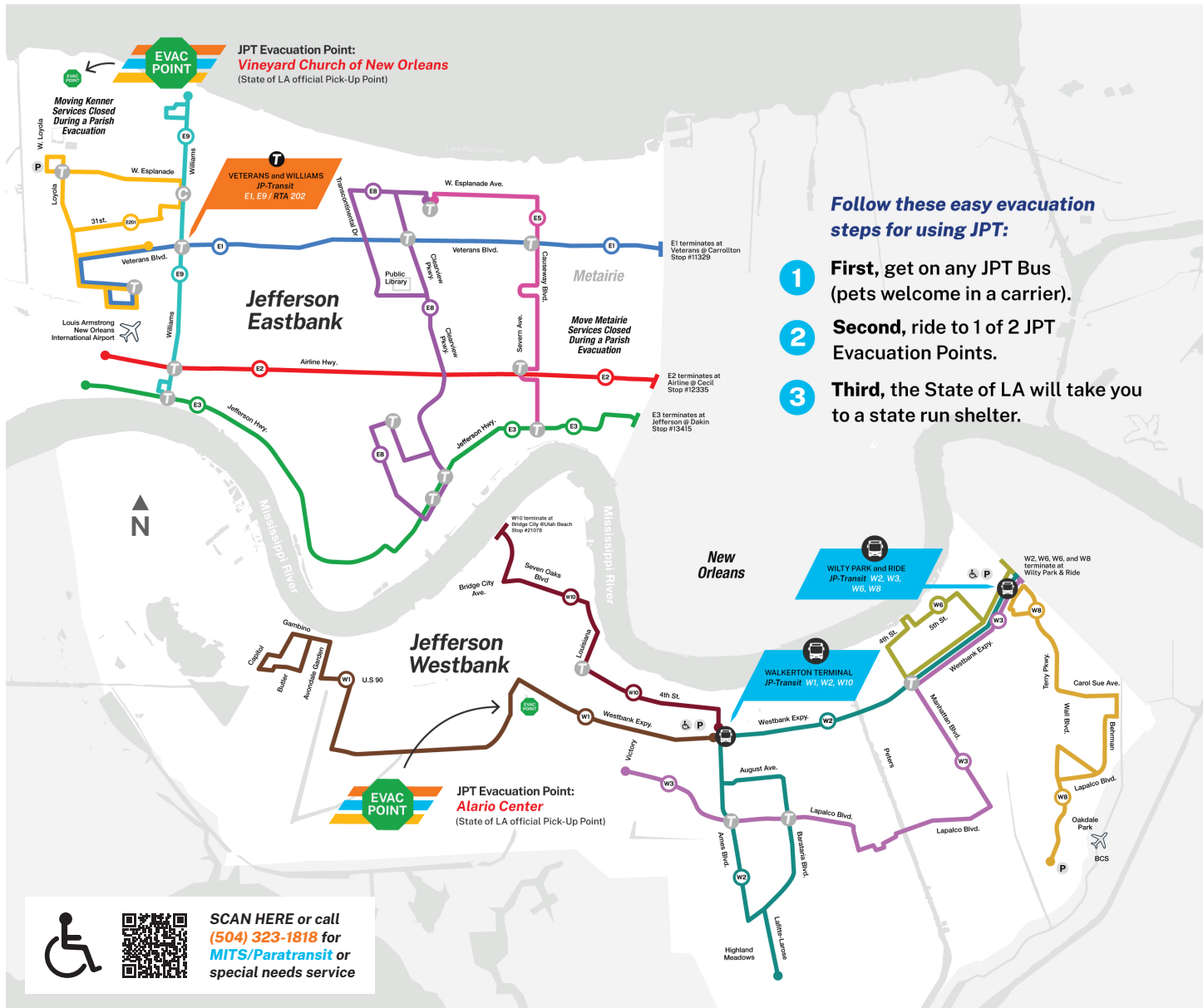
In the event of a hurricane, the Jefferson Parish Transit system will maintain regular bus service until the Parish is placed under a mandatory evacuation notice when threatened by a Category 3, 4, or 5 Hurricane. **At that time, the regularly scheduled fixed route service will be replaced with the Hurricane Evacuation System (See map on this page).**

Please Note:

- No fares will be collected during Hurricane Evacuation.
- JPT operators will pick up passengers at JPT bus stops along the designated routes.
- Riders are limited to one bag per person no larger than 30" x 16".
- JP-Transit will transport animals only in carriers. If transporting large or exotic animals, please call Jefferson Parish Transit at (504) 818-1077.

MITS / Paratransit Service Hurricane Evacuation Procedure:

Before a storm discuss your plans for evacuation with your family. Visit www.getagameplan.org for details. If a major hurricane approaches, and the Parish President declares a mandatory evacuation, **the Parish will activate its special needs evacuation assistance plans to help those without means to evacuate.** Please call (504) 323-1818 to register.



Follow these easy evacuation steps for using JPT:

- 1 First, get on any JPT Bus (pets welcome in a carrier).
- 2 Second, ride to 1 of 2 JPT Evacuation Points.
- 3 Third, the State of LA will take you to a state run shelter.

Eastbank Routes

The following Eastbank routes will bring riders to the JPT Evacuation Point at the Vineyard Church of New Orleans. The State of LA will then take you to state run shelters. Please note the JPT fares and transfers are FREE.

-  **E1 Veterans-Airport**
Two buses will run on Veterans between Veterans and Loyola and the Jefferson/Orleans Parish line. Riders will transfer to the E8 Elmwood route at Veterans and Clearview to travel to the JPT Eastbank Evacuation Point at Vineyard Church of New Orleans.
-  **E2 Airline Highway**
Two buses will run on Airline between Kenner Terminal Parking Garage and Jefferson/Orleans Parish line. Riders will transfer to the E8 Elmwood at Airline and Clearview to travel to the JPT Eastbank Evacuation Point at Vineyard Church of New Orleans.
-  **E3 Jefferson Highway**
Two buses will run on Jefferson Highway between the Jefferson/St. Charles Parish line to the Jefferson/Orleans Parish line. Riders will transfer to the E8 Elmwood route at Elmwood Park Blvd. to the JPT Eastbank Evacuation Point at Vineyard Church of New Orleans.
-  **E5 Causeway**
One bus will run between East Jefferson Hospital and Jefferson Highway. Riders will transfer to the E2 Airline route at Airline to travel on to the JPT Eastbank Evacuation Point at Vineyard Church of New Orleans.
-  **E8 Elmwood**
Two buses will run between East Jefferson Hospital and Jefferson Highway. Riders will be dropped off at the JPT Eastbank Evacuation Point at Vineyard Church of New Orleans.
-  **E9 Williams**
The E9 Williams route provides service along Williams Boulevard, operating between Jefferson Highway and Treasure Chest Casino. Passengers may transfer to the E201 Kenner Airport Loop at Williams Boulevard & 33rd Street for service to the airport and Ochsner Medical Center.
-  **E201 Kenner**
Two buses will run between Kenner Rivertown and MSY Airport. Riders will be dropped off at the JPT Eastbank Evacuation at Vineyard Church of New Orleans.

Westbank Routes

The following Westbank routes will bring riders to the Parish Westbank JPT Evacuation Point at Alario Center. The State of LA will then take you to state run shelters. Please note the JPT fares and transfers are FREE.

-  **W1 Avondale**
One bus will run the normal route from Avondale (Senate Dr. @ Capitol) to the JPT Westbank Evacuation Point at Alario Center.
-  **W2 Westbank Expressway**
Two buses will travel from the Willy Terminal to the Walkertown Terminal then to the JPT Westbank Evacuation Point at Alario Center. (No service across the Crescent City Connection).
-  **W3 Lapalco**
Two buses will travel from Westbank Expressway @ Manhattan, down Manhattan to Lapalco and then to the JPT Westbank Evacuation Point at Alario Center.
-  **W6 Gretna**
One bus will travel on its regular route to the Willy Terminal. Riders will transfer to the W2 Westbank Expressway route at the Willy Terminal to the JPT Westbank Evacuation Point at Alario Center.
-  **W8 Terrytown**
One bus will travel on its regular route in Terrytown to the Willy Terminal. Riders will transfer to the W2 Westbank Expressway route at the Willy Terminal to the JPT Westbank Evacuation Point at Alario Center.
-  **W10 Huey P. Long**
One bus will travel on its regular route from Walkertown Terminal to Bridge City (No service across the Huey P. Long Bridge). Riders will transfer to the W2 Expressway route at the Walkertown Terminal to travel to the JPT Westbank Evacuation Point at Alario Center.
